From the South

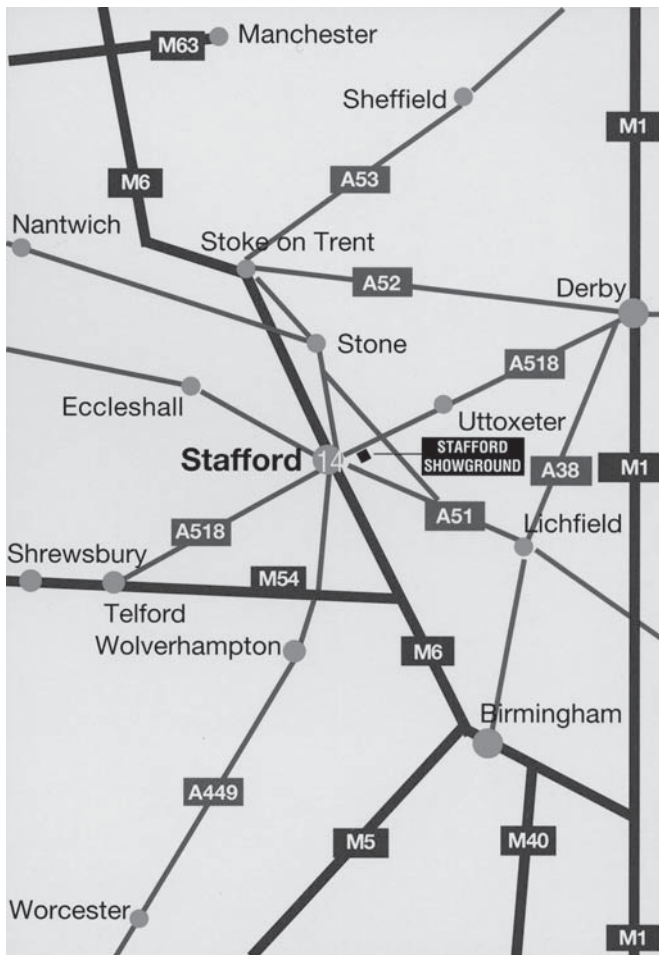
- M5, M6. Exit M6 motorway at junction 14. Follow A518 and signposts for Stafford Showground.

ARTMEIS VETERAN OF YEAR FINALS

Will be held at the National Dog Show on Saturday 11th May 2024

The final will be held after group judging is completed at the National Dog Show.

It is anticipated the final will commence at around 6.30pm.

The winner to receive £500 plus a bed kindly donated by Charley Chau Luxury Dog Beds and the Reserve Veteran of the Year will receive £250.

All present will receive a finalist's rosette and other donated prizes.

The final will be judged on a points system with three judges awarding points for type, conformation and movement. The dog receiving the most points will be deemed to be:-

THE ARTMEIS VETERAN OF THE YEAR

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING BENCHING & IDENTIFICATION OF DOGS

It is a Royal Kennel Club requirement that exhibitors display the exhibit/bench number on their crate, cage or container at all times. This is particularly important when cages etc. are not on benches, and at unbenced shows.

Each exhibitor is responsible for providing their own crate or cage identification and should note that the original exhibit/bench number card, as provided by the show society, must not be used for this purpose.

It is important to be able to contact exhibitors and identify dogs where a dog may be in distress or where the crate might be blocking a gangway.

At benced shows soft crates may only be put on benches if they are the appropriate size for both the dog and the bench, and the crate can be securely attached to the bench.

Both of these points were introduced with the safety of all in mind, but most importantly that of the dog, and to minimise potential incidents and injuries.

The Royal Kennel Club would also take this opportunity to remind exhibitors that Show Regulation F(1).16 requires that dogs should be present on their benches at all times except when being judged, prepared for exhibition or exercised.

Opportunities for Good Citizen Bronze Testing at the National Dog Show

The National Dog Show is offering Good Citizen Bronze Testing at the show each day.

The test incorporates simple exercises like walking on a lead with distractions, grooming, stay on a lead, recall and basic control exercises.

Participants must ensure:-

- Their dog is wearing a collar with the name and the address of the owner either inscribed on the collar or on a disc attached to it.
- Their dog is microchipped.
- Handler must show they have means to clean up after their dog.
- The KC registration certificate must also be brought to the show.

Testing sessions will be held from 10 am until 2 pm each day. Ring location to be confirmed.

Entries are taken on the day at a cost of £5 per dog. **(cash payments only).**

ALTERATION TO SCHEDULE

PARKING FACILITIES FOR DISABLED EXHIBITORS AND VISITORS

A forward parking area will be allocated in each car park for the use of disabled exhibitors and visitors. Vehicles displaying the official parking disc will be directed by the car parking staff on the day.

CARAVANS/MOTORHOMES

£60 pre-booked (for the duration of the show), **£70 if booked on site**. Space on the caravan site is limited and early booking is advised. Overnight booking cannot be pre-booked but (if space is available) can be booked on site at a cost of £15 per night. Caravans will be parked in a separate eight-acre field adjacent to the showground and linked by a tarmac footpath. Facilities include a toilet block (including disabled), shower block (in main building and accessible 24 hours), chemical disposal point and a fire point. A woodland site is available for exercising dogs on the strict understanding that dogs are kept on a lead at all times and any fouling is removed immediately, as this is a picnic area. **Caravans will only be allowed on the site from 10.00 am on Tuesday 7th May and must be removed by 12 noon on Monday 13th May 2024.**

Please note that each caravan will be allocated a space of 10 metres in width. All equipment, including awning, windbreaks etc. must be contained within the allocated space and individual units must not be linked. **Although there is no extra charge for Caravans/Motorhomes over 10 metres in length it is essential to specify a larger pitch is required as spaces for these vehicles are limited.** All arrivals should report to the Society's appointed warden(s) who are in control of the site and anyone not complying with his/her instructions will be asked to leave the site. **NB. This is a temporary caravan site more suited to self-contained units. MOTORHOMES/CARAVANS MUST NOT BE PARKED OVERNIGHT IN THE CAR PARK. All caravans must carry a fire extinguisher.**

NO UNENTERED DOG TENT

An unentered dog tent will NOT be provided at the 2024 Show.

SPECTATOR DOGS

Spectator Dogs from 4 months of age may be brought into the show. On arrival please report to the Catalogue table in the morning or Secretary's Office in the afternoon. A brief form must be completed and a fee of £5.00 paid.

To ensure your dogs' safety at our show passes will be issued for all Spectator Dogs and a fee of £5.00 per dog will be payable. Passes for all will be checked on leaving the show ground. No dog will be checked out of the showground without an appropriate pass.

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RIGHTS

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the Organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet

sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the ring at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

FOULING

Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s), and/or any grooming waste, at any Royal Kennel Club Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling/grooming waste will be provided by the Society. It is not acceptable to “pick up” after your dog and then leave the bag underneath your vehicle for others to collect at the end of the day.

EYE TESTING SESSIONS

Lorna Newman BVMS CertVOphthal MRCVS will be holding eye testing sessions under the BVA/KC/ISDS Scheme from 9.30am until 3pm each day. The cost of the test will be £50. No appointment is necessary. Please remember to bring along the dog's Royal Kennel Club registration form. Gonioscopy testing may be available depending on demand on the day. The cost for both Gonioscopy and Eye Testing will be £85.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

Regrettably the Society has been receiving an increasing number of reports of verbal/physical assaults on security staff, particularly when collecting Removal Orders at the main gate. Exhibitors are advised that this behaviour is not acceptable and that it is the intention of the Society to refuse further entries where it is possible to positively identify the perpetrators of such anti-social behaviour. Please remember that any official personnel on the showground are carrying out their duties as per instructions issued by the Management Committee of Birmingham Dog Show Society Ltd.

You are reminded that Removal Orders MUST be produced when leaving the showground for ALL dogs in your vehicle. Passes will be issued for Spectator Dogs entered at the show.

GANGWAYS

Gangways must be kept clear at all times. Any obstructions including dog boxes left in gangways will be removed by the Show Management.

USE OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AT SHOWS

Electrical equipment should not be brought to shows unless absolutely necessary. In rare instances where it might be required, it should be PAT tested and permission sought from the Show Secretary before it is used.

Vicious dogs are not eligible and must not be brought to the Show
Exhibitors are held responsible for any damage done by their dog during the exhibition.

- 1 The show will open at 7.00 a.m. daily.
- 2 Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3 Breed Judging will commence at 9.00 a.m. prompt unless otherwise advised. YKC classes will commence at 8.30 a.m.
- 4
 - a. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed.
 - b. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner, or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to The Royal Kennel Club.
 - c. The show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 Entry fees: Breeds with CCs on offer — 1st entry £31. Breeds without CCs on offer, AV Imported Register, Stakes Classes — 1st entry £19. Not For Competition — £10.00. Four or more dogs — £110. The Young Kennel Club Members' Handling/Adult Handling — £5 per class. All subsequent entries with the same dog — £5. KC Breeders' Competition — £15.00. Catalogues — £7 (£8 on the day). All entry fees and other charges quoted in this schedule are inclusive of VAT where this tax is applicable. Entries can be made online at www.higham-press.co.uk. **FIRST ENTRY FEES INCREASE BY £2 DURING THE EXTENDED ONLINE PERIOD FROM 7th MARCH. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY IS MADE. ANY REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES OR UNDERAGE PUPPIES WILL INCUR A £5 ADMIN FEE.**
- 6 Prize money, where paid, is detailed under the relevant Stakes Classes.
- 7 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age after the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition. **i.e. born on or after 10th November 2023.**
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- 10 **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - a. **Shows Judged on the Group System** - (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F.(1).27.b)
 - (1) **Best Puppy in Breed**
 A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered and unbeaten by another puppy in the breed classes.
 A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).
 A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).
 - (2) **Best Puppy in Group**
 Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - (a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed
 - (b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - (c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
 - (3) **Best Puppy in Show**
 Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.
- 11 **BEST IN SHOW:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a. **Shows Judged on the Group System**
 - (1) **Best of Breed**
 Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
 NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.
 - (2) **Best of Group**
 Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
 - (a) The Best of Breed winners in each group
 - (b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
 - (c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.
 NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by The Royal Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.
 - (3) **Best in Show**
 Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Royal Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Royal Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B)—Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Royal Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and The Royal Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Royal Kennel Club licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade — take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of The Royal Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 Not For Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Royal Kennel Club registered. Regulation F.1.c: Only dogs of six calendar months of age and over on the first day of the show are eligible for exhibition at Royal Kennel Club licensed shows. However societies may accept Not for Competition entries at their discretion and dogs aged four calendar months and over are eligible to enter Not for Competition at all Royal Kennel Club licensed Shows. Furthermore, dogs aged four calendar months and over are eligible to enter Match Competitions.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of The Royal Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW.** On 1 January 2015 The Royal Kennel Club suspended The Royal Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulated that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs were eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions. **From 1 January 2018 this suspension will be made permanent and included in the F Regulations.** Please note that for the purposes of Royal Kennel Club Show Regulations the term "Variety Class" also applies to "Stakes Classes". A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed can compete. Best Veteran in Show is a Veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other Veteran exhibited at the same show.
- Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from any breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
 - Best Veteran In Group will be selected from all Best Veteran in Breed provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
 - Best Veteran In Show will be selected from Best Veteran in Group Winners provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
- Proviso** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- NB:** Veterans entered in the Veteran Stakes ONLY are not eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Show. To be eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Show, a veteran must be entered and exhibited in a breed class and win Best Veteran in Breed and Best Veteran in Group.
- 21 The Catalogue will contain the owners' name in each breed in alphabetical order with their dogs in numerical order. All dogs will be benched in the catalogue order and owners' dogs of the same breed will be benched together. No decorations, pictures, cards or other notices may be placed over the benches except the Official Prize Cards and exhibitors name and address as per Royal K.C. Regulations. No bench numbers shall be changed from one pen to another and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered pen. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY PARTITIONS BETWEEN DOGS BE REMOVED.**
- 22 Exhibitors will receive one free pass (not transferable) for each dog entered.
- 23 All dogs must be removed from their benches within 30 minutes of the completion of Group judging on the first, second and third days, and after the Best in Show judging on the final day.
- 24 All dogs must have a benching chain and collar. (Cages will not be provided for Toydogs).
- 25 **EXHIBITS ONLY ALLOWED.** No animal other than a dog duly entered at the show will be allowed within the precincts of the show during its continuance, except by prior permission of The Royal Kennel Club.

- 26 Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the Committee reserves to itself the right to appoint a substitute. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, **but no entry fees can be returned.**
- 27 Should any question arise, not provided for by these Regulations or by The Royal Kennel Club Rules, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject only to appeal to The Royal Kennel Club.
- 28 Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
- 29 The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Royal Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This Regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event).
- 30 **CANCELLATION OR ABANDONMENT.** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any Act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show after entries have closed.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

N.B. —The word “dog” includes both sexes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the first closing date shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. Wednesday 28th February 2024.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- 1) *Withdrawal*
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F.(1).19.
- 2) *Transfer*
 - (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height, or in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

MAIDEN—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or a First Prize at an Open or Championship show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

NOVICE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

MID LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won five or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the show.

CHAMPION—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Royal Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

NOT FOR COMPETITION—Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

YKC STAKES—i. This schedule information MUST be read in conjunction with the full set of YKC Stakes rules available on the Young Kennel Club website.

- a. By entering this class, you confirm that you have read and understood the accompanying full set of YKC rules.
- ii. Members must be a YKC member before entering the competition.
- iii. YKC Stakes Classes have one age category for you to enter a. 06-24 years.
- iv. First place in each subcategory will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2025.
- a. Further qualification methods can be viewed by reading the full rules.
- b. You may enter this class even if you have previously qualified in this class.
- v. YKC Class may be the first and only entry at this show.

YKC HANDLING CLASSES—i. This schedule information MUST be read in conjunction with the full set of YKC Stakes rules available on the Young Kennel Club website.

- a. By entering this class, you confirm that you have read and understood the accompanying full set of YKC rules.
- ii. Members must be a YKC member before entering this competition.
- iii. YKC Handling Classes have 3 different age categories for you to enter
 - a. 06-11 years
 - b. 12-17 years
 - c. 18-24 years
- iv. May enter a dog from one of the 8 different groups:
 - a. Utility
 - b. Toy
 - c. Terrier
 - d. Hound
 - e. Working
 - f. Pastoral
 - g. Gundog
 - h. Crossbreed
- v. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in YKC Handling Classes.
- vi. A record of the dog's Royal Kennel Club registered name along with the handler's name will be kept, this will determine which class they enter at Crufts (and by extension which day).
 - a. After entries have closed, competitors may only switch dogs if both:
 - (1) The dog is in the same group
 - (2) The dog is already entered at the show
- vii. Members should enter the age category they would be on the first day of this show.
- viii. First place in each subcategory will guarantee qualification to Crufts 2025
 - a. Further qualification methods can be viewed by reading the full rules
 - b. You may enter this class even if you have previously qualified in this class

ADULT HANDLING For handlers of the ages stated in each class.

KENNEL CLUB GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS—For dogs which have obtained their Good Citizen Bronze award or above.

SPECIAL NATIVE VULNERABLE BREEDS STAKES—Open to dogs from breeds on The Royal Kennel Club list of Vulnerable Native Breeds. For dogs which have not become Show Champions under The Royal Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Royal Kennel Club.

KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION—Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in The Royal Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The top 40 teams will qualify including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

THE KENNEL CLUB SPECIAL BEGINNERS COMPETITION

The Royal Kennel Club is delighted to announce its sponsorship of a Special Beginners Competition in 2024 at General and Group Championship Shows, to encourage more exhibitors to experience a Group competition.

The Class definition is: For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

The Royal Kennel Club will provide sponsorship in the form of Rosettes 1st - 4th for each group together with prize money of £100 for each group to be awarded as follows: 1st prize £40; 2nd prize £30; 3rd prize £20; 4th prize £10.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Royal Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
- 2
 - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to The Royal Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
- 4 The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from The Royal Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by The Royal Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Royal Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any advertisement for a coat preparation or shampoo or similar in either schedule or catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparation may not contravene Royal Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition-F(B). This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at The National Dog Show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the declaration they are required to sign on the entry form.

WELFARE OF DOGS — An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Royal Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Royal Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE— In accordance with Royal Kennel Club guidelines, Exhibitors must display exhibit number/owner identification on their crate, cage or container at all times.
